Children will be working to improve their gymnastic skills, understanding how to receive body weight. In Games lessons, we will be playing football to improve ball control.



English

Our topic is Myths and Legends and, to link to our Geography topic, we will base our writing on the legend of Robin Hood. Children will be describing settings and characters, making Robin Hood hats and doing role play activities, before writing their own version of 'The Silver Arrow'. For report writing, we will look at the mystery of the Loch Ness Monster and the book Water Horse by Dick King-Smith.

Music

Geography/History

Our topic, this term, is the United Kingdom. We will be looking at physical and man-made features in our local area and throughout the UK, and creating a 3D map. In History, we will be learning about Roman Britain, looking at invasions, life as a Roman soldier and exploring evidence of Roman life in our area.

Science
