

Geography

We will be learning about London and identifying human and physical features.

History

We will be learning about 'The Great Fire of London' and of significant historical figures, such as Samuel Pepys.

PE We will be developing our throwing, passing and catching skills, in a netball context.

We will be exploring dance and will be creating dances based on our 'Great Fire of London' topic.

Music We will be using instruments to create compositions based on 'The Great Fire of London' and will start to think about how to record compositions, using ICT.

Science

We will be learning about materials and their uses. We will learn about some of the properties of materials and will consider how different materials can be changed.

English

We will be looking at narrative stories with familiar settings, fairy tales and traditional stories.

We will listen to stories about 'The Great Fire of London' and write recounts based on these events. We will also write instructions linked to our work about The Great Fire.

We will study a range of contemporary and classic poetry and will start to learn poems by heart, before performing them.

Computing

We will use different ICT tools to create different effects, and will be creating Calligrams linked to our poetry work in English.

Art and Design

We will explore representations of buildings and landmarks in art and we will study the work of artist Stephen Wiltshire.

Design and Technology

We will make models of houses linked to 'The Great Fire of London' and will use these to recreate a street scene of Pudding Lane.

Maths

We will be exploring numbers and place value, looking particularly at partitioning numbers when we add them together. We will count forwards and backwards in different sized jumps, and will use <, > and = to compare numbers. We will work on learning our x2, x5 and x10 tables (using Mathematics to help us with this) and explore the relationship between multiplication and division. We will also start to look at collecting and graphing data, and will explore the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

RE

We will be learning about signs and symbols in religions.

PSHE

We will be thinking about being responsible and staying safe. We will also have weekly Pupil Voice sessions.
