

Geography

We will be extending our geographical and locational knowledge of Europe. We will use atlases to identify different features and will compare and contrast places.

English

Traditional Tales—We will be using our extended vocabulary to write our own version of a traditional tale.

Recount and playscripts—We will be writing newspaper reports and playscripts based on the traditional story of The Three Little Pigs.

Non-Chronological Report—We will be writing a fact based report linked to our work on the Stone Age, from last term.

There will be a continued focus on sentence structure. We will be using subordinating conjunctions, speech punctuation and paragraphs throughout this term.

Art

We will be investigating European artists such as Gaudi and Picasso and will use their work as starting points for exploring art, using different media.

Computing

This term, we will be learning to use commands to create effects on screen. We will debug sequences of commands and will use Scratch to develop our own computer games.

Science

We will be learning about nutrition, sorting foods into food groups and looking at how much animals need to eat in order to stay healthy. We will also study what plants need to stay healthy and how skeletons and muscles protect, support and help us move.

PE We will be inventing our own games, focusing on tactics and scoring systems and we will be learning Spanish dances.

Music We will learn about families of instruments and will singing whilst adding musical accompaniment.

Maths

We will be looking at 2D shape, where we will revisit symmetry, the size of angles and explore perpendicular and parallel lines. We will use the different methods of addition and subtraction, learnt in the Autumn term, to solve perimeter based problems. There will be a large focus on multiplication and division problems using the 2, 3, 4, 5 & 8 times tables we have been learning. These multiplication and division facts will also be used to build upon our existing knowledge of fractions so we can find fractions of an amount as well as fractions of a shape.

RE We will be exploring key events in Jesus' life and how he overcame temptation. We will also learn about Hinduism and how Christians celebrate Easter and Lent.

Spanish We will learn different ways to greet people and to describe.
