Nursery Pupils

Please note that there will be **no** morning Nursery on the following dates. On these days, pupils should attend in the afternoon, 1pm until 3.15pm: Wednesday 19th December (Performance Day, 2.00pm **and** 6.30pm. Nursery pupils should arrive at 6.00pm for the evening performance). The afternoon of Tuesday 18th December will be our Party Day and, again, Nursery pupils should attend from 1pm - 3.15pm.

Tuesday 11th December

Tickets go on sale at the school office for our Christmas productions. Please note that, like last year, the Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 will have separate performances from Key Stage 2, as there are too many pupils to fit on the stage at the same time. There will be a small charge for attendance at these performances - £1 for children of primary school age and £3.00 for everyone else. A raffle will be drawn for a Christmas hamper at the final evening performance. Tickets for this hamper raffle, which cost £1.00 per strip, will be available at all performances and will also be on sale in the school office.

Wednesday 12th December

This will be Christmas dinner day for all pupils from Reception to Year 6.

Monday 17th December (pm)

The Snow Queen performed by Market Theatre actors.

Tuesday 18th December

This will be party afternoon. Each teacher will send out details of their class's party needs. All children should come to school in their school uniform, but with some party clothes to change into for the afternoon.

Thursday 20th December

At 2.00pm, there will be the first of two performances of our Christmas Concerts performed by our children. The afternoon will be the family performance, where children under school age may attend. However, parents are reminded that if babies or toddlers become unsettled during the performance, they should be taken outside, so as not to spoil the performance for the children on the stage.

At 6.30pm, there will be the evening performance. The children will need to be back in school at 6pm on the evening of their performance (Wednesday 19th December: Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and Thursday 20th December: Years 3 - 6). Evening performances are not suitable for children under school age.

Parents are requested to turn off mobile telephones during the performance. Car parking will be available on the infant playground for the afternoon performances and on the junior playground for the evening performances. If you wish to use a still or video camera at any concert, please inform the school office as soon as possible (a letter about this will be issued next week). Please note that secondary aged children will only be admitted if they are with a parent and they have a brother or sister in the concert. Unaccompanied teenagers will not be allowed in. Wheelchair access is available.

Refreshments will be available. A big thank you to the PSA for doing this for us all.

Friday 21st December

This is the last day of term for Purwell School. Children in Year 1 to Year 6 may bring in a small game or activity but should not bring anything electronic or expensive. Everyone is welcome to join us at 1.20 pm for our Award Assembly where we will end the term with award certificates and some festive singing.
