Year 1:

Sequence sentences to form simple non-fiction text types.

Punctuates most single-clause sentences with a capital letter, full stop, exclamation mark or question mark.

Punctuates multi-clause sentences, which use the coordinating conjunction 'and', some of the time.

Uses time words to aid sequencing e.g. first, next, then

Year 2:

Uses sentences with different forms: statement, question, exclamation, command

Punctuates single clause sentences and multi-clause sentences using co-ordinating conjunctions mostly accurately
