

Computing

Discovering Programming - We will be writing programs and algorithms to control moving devices and create effects on screen.

RE - We will learn about belonging and identity.

PSHE and Citizenship – Linked to our Design and Technology work, we will learn about staying healthy.

English

To start the term, we will be writing instructions based on the story of 'The Last Noo Noo'. We will also learn about traditional tales and study poetry, planning, writing and publishing our own traditional tales and poems.

The children will become explorers and will research information about a chosen place or location. They will use their research to create fact files and encyclopaedia entries.

History
