We would like to share an update on the recent work of the Governing Board following our latest meeting. The meeting covered several key areas related to the school's ongoing development and improvement.

Governors reviewed the school's financial position to ensure resources are being used effectively to support learning and development. Updates were provided on our commitment to maintaining a safe and inclusive environment for all children. Governors discussed progress on our school improvement priorities and explored ways to enhance learning experiences. The board reviewed how funding is being used to promote physical activity and provide additional support for eligible pupils. Three key policies, Disposal of Equipment, Safer Recruitment and Flexible Learning, were reviewed and formally approved.

Bullying Update and Reminder

I am pleased to share that there have been no reported incidents of bullying in the last few weeks, which is fantastic news for our school community. As always, we remain committed to fostering a safe, inclusive, and supportive environment for all pupils. Should any incidents arise in the future, we will continue to keep parents informed about how they are being addressed.

As we end this Spring term, it is a good time to remind parents of the school's definition of bullying, to ensure a shared understanding at home and in school. At Purwell, we define bullying as:

"A systematic and extended victimisation of a person or group, by another, or group of others."

To help children understand this, we use the acronym **BOO**:

- ♦ Being mean
- ◊ On purpose
- $\diamond~~\textbf{O} ver$ and over

This simple approach helps pupils remember what bullying is and how to recognise it.

<u>Closing infant pedestrian gates</u>

A reminder to parents who use the infant pedestrian gate, that they must ensure that they close it after they go through it. Twice last week it was left open after morning drop-off and at Nursery pick-up time. Thank you for supporting our ongoing commitment to safeguard our children. In addition to this, more generally, please ensure that you close all gates behind you when entering or leaving the school site between the hours of 9am and 3pm.

We kindly remind parents to avoid taking their children on holiday during term time. Such absences disrupt your child's learning and can impact the overall school environment. The government has recently introduced a new national framework for penalty notices regarding unauthorised term-time holidays. These measures are now in effect.
