<u>Sports Day - Wednesday 28th June</u>

This year, Sports Day will be on Wednesday 28th June. The organisation of the day will be like previous years, with children taking part in a range of athletic events such as long jump, javelin, and discus, in addition to running races on the track. In the morning, from 9:30am, it will be the turn of Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 children: Acorn, Holly, and Willow Classes, with Key Stage 2 children: Beech, Maple, Aspen and Oak competing in the afternoon, from 1:30pm.

Teachers will be making sure that children have the opportunity to practise each of the events as part of their PE lessons this term. All children should make sure they have their PE kit (including proper trainers) in school so that they can take part. Parents are most welcome to watch their children on Sports Day - come and join us!

Open Day/Evening - Wednesday 12th July

The Open Day and Open Evening for parents will be on Wednesday 12th July. Parents are invited to come into their child's class, from 2.15pm until 3.15pm, where they will be invited to join the children in fun learning activities which reflect our diverse and creative curriculum.

To accommodate the later-working parents, the school will open again at 6.00pm with refreshments in the hall, where Mr Cano will be saying a few words before introducing to the parents the teachers for September and announcing class allocations. There will also be a representation from the school governors and PSA members who will be delighted to answer any questions for parents looking to be more involved in the school. There will be displays of children's work, subject information, and interactive computer demonstrations, with staff and pupils available to guide and answer any questions.
