

PE

We will be concentrating on throwing and catching skills and developing our techniques in Gymnastics and Dance. We will be performing a Dance to tell the story of The Great Fire of London to show all of the brilliant things we have learned.

English

To start this term, we will be looking at a range of poetry and learning how to compare in terms of layout, style and rhyming words. We will take ideas from the poems we study and create our own.

Following this, we will be reading the diary of Samuel Pepys. We will be writing our own diary entry as if we were involved in The Great Fire of London. We will be focussing on time connectives and expanded noun phrases as we describe the fire.

We will also be learning all about newspaper reports, again focussing on The Great Fire of London. We will focus on writing in the past tense, along with using a range of punctuation.

Science

We will be learning to classify and compare different materials and their characteristics. We will be studying how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

Geography

This term, we will be learning to understand and identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom, linking to the location of hot and cold areas around the world in relation to the equator.

History

As our topic states, we will be concentrating on the events of The Great Fire of London this term and get to know many important people and places which were involved during 1666.

The Great Fire of London

Art and Design

We will be studying the work of Lowry and recreating our own pictures of the streets of London, learning a range of different techniques using pencil.

Music

In Music, we will be using our voices to perform 'London's Burning'. We will sing in unison and in rounds, before creating our own lyrics. We will also learn how to play a range of simple songs on the recorder, using musical notation to help us.

Computing

We will use ICT to research and present information about topics that we are studying and will present our information to an audience.

Maths

This term, we will be securing our fluency to twenty, as well as concentrating on place value to help us to solve addition and subtraction problems. We will be ordering and comparing numbers before starting the topic of Money– making and comparing amounts and finding the correct amount of change.

Throughout this term, we will be continuously working hard to learn our 2, 5 and 10 times tables and finding new ways to solve problems involving the 4 operations – addition, subtraction, division and multiplication.

RE

We will be studying Christianity this term, including special places and celebrations.

PSHE

We will be looking at the 1Decision unit named 'Hazard Watch', which is all about exploring and Identifying potential dangers in different environments.
